

# SENIOR MOMENTS

## 2017 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS They have changed as of April 2017

### HEALTHCARE

**Part D Help:** 75% or more drug assistance through Federal Government.  
Income - \$18,330 annual single and \$24,600 annual married  
Assets - \$13,820 single and \$27,600 married

**Missouri Rx:** Prescription drug assistance through State of Missouri.  
Income - \$21,660 annual single and \$29,140 annual married  
Assets do not affect eligibility.

**Medicaid:** Medical care through State of Missouri for disabled or those 65 and older.  
\*Income - \$834/month single and \$1129/month married OR meet spend-down through medical expenses.  
Assets - \$1,000 single and \$2,000 married (does not include house or car)

**Medicare Premiums:** (assistance through State of Missouri)

\*QMB: Payment of Medicare premiums, coinsurance and deductibles.  
Income - \$1005/month single and \$1354/month married  
Assets - \$7,280 single and \$10,930 married

\*SLMB Group 1: Payment of Medicare Part B premium.  
Income - \$1206 month single and \$1624 married  
Assets - \$7,280 single and \$10,930 married

\*SLMB Group 2: Payment of Medicare Part B premium.  
Income - \$1357/month single and \$1827/month married  
Assets - \$7,280 single and \$10,930 married

\*These income limits in effect since April 1, 2017

### IN-HOME CARE

**Home and Community Based Services** (HCB through State of Missouri): 63 years or older; monthly income at or below \$1285 (as of Jan 1, 2017); needs level of care provided in a nursing home.

### **Veterans Aid and Attendance:**

Must be a veteran or surviving spouse of a veteran who has served 90 days or more on active duty with one day during a period of war. Cannot be driving, no other VA pension, must have a non-service medical-related condition. Income requirements can be offset by medical expenses. Liquid asset requirements do not include house or car.

**Alzheimer's Association** (432-3422):

**Respite Care Assistance Program** can help pay for care for a loved one with dementia while primary caregiver gets a short break. Income does not affect eligibility. Application and physician's statement must be completed.

**Family Support Fund** provides financial assistance up to an annual maximum of \$500 per family (renewable for one year) for expenses related to the care of a loved one at home diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia. Assistance granted on a first-come-first-serve basis for as long as funds are available for that year. There are no income requirements for eligibility; however, because funds are limited, potential applicants should pursue insurance coverage first and applications should reflect a genuine financial need. Application and physician's statement must be completed. Person with dementia must live at home.



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, the Church marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first Marian apparition to three young shepherds in Fatima, and the Holy Father will formally canonize now-Blessed Francisco and Jacinta Marto. While some cynics might dismiss the value of the events of a century ago in that small village to three small children, they nevertheless cannot deny the impact the messages of Fatima have had in the life of the Church and the world.

Going back a hundred years, Europe itself was in a period of foment still rumbling after the Napoleonic wars, with the competition amongst nations seeking further expansion and influence into the far corners of the world, the socio-economic issues with the continuing rise of urban industry, let alone the intensification of anti-religious forces of socialism and communism. The mountains and sea might have protected Portugal to a degree in the past, but they were not enough to shield this small nation from the eruptions of political, social, economic and religious movements. Amid all this, Providence would intervene in the mess of human history through three small children to call us back to Him and to embrace His mercy through acts of prayer and sacrifices of reparation.

While some may focus on the “secrets” of Fatima, the Church often emphasizes the importance of its basic message: the need for conversion and our role as Christians in the plan of salvation. Much like the floods our area has experienced over the past week, the evil left by sin comes to flood families, communities, countries and the world not necessarily through one great act of sin, but rather a collection of many, many acts contrary to what is good, right and true. Without repentance, without those willing to stave off the flood of sin or to clean up its effects through prayer and sacrifice, evil putrefies the human heart and society leading to a loss of the perception of God and the value of the human creature made in His image and likeness. In the rejection of God, humanity leases hell upon itself, but by returning to Him and seeking His mercy, the human heart can know peace.

As for our role salvation, the Lord does not leave us as passive spectators, but we are enabled by grace to be active players in His plan. Why would He ask us to carry our cross daily to follow Him, to pray without ceasing, to love God above else and our neighbor for love of God, etc., if it were otherwise? We are that “chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a People of His own” (1 Peter 2:9), and we have our own part that the Mercy of God may be known and fruitful in our world. Jesus speaks of those who believe in Him doing the works that He does and even greater ones (John 14:12). We can see the effects those who have done works of mercy to address sin and bring healing to humanity, whether of the corporal kind (feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, ransoming the captive, etc.) or of the spiritual (instructing the ignorant, admonishing sinners, praying for the living and the dead, etc.). Fatima particularly encourages the daily Rosary and sacrifices for poor souls.

Fatima challenges Christians to recognize not only the reality of evil in the world, but also their dignity as members of the Mystical Body of Christ to bring about conversion and healing from the effects of sin. Perhaps the question for us is whether we believe?
